

...250 'lodges' have already been bought

LAVUMISA - About 250 plots have already been bought for the construction of lodges as part of the Royal Jozini Big Six project.

Out of the 250, four have already been developed and the lodges are almost ready for occupation.

Two more are still under construction.

The project's Marketing Manager Sifiso Dlamini said they had already handed over the title deeds in all the sold plots.

In total, 560 lodges will be in the market as the project progresses.

The construction of the lodges should be in line with architectural guidelines given by the project directors.

During a site visit to the complete lodges, one was con-

structed with timber and steel and is worth about E8 million.

It comprises of five bedrooms all ensuite, a kitchenette, bar, swimming pool and a boma, amongst other features.

Another has a thatched roof finish worth about E5.5 million which shall be ready for occupation soon.

Dlamini said, "Some of the investors have built the lodges for personal use while others will lease them out. With the bigger lodges, they usually take two plots and join them."

The project will also encompass a gold estate which shall have an additional 400 lodges and a hotel.
