



LETTER ON DONATION

It has been a frustrating year for all concerned with regards to game introduction into the Royal Jozini Game Reserve. Despite the fact that our current game is faring well and their numbers are steadily increasing most of these sightings take place on the west of our reserve, we understand that we still have a long way to go when it comes to stocking the Nature reserve and the large expanse up North. Our aim was to go a long way in fulfilling this obligation by strategic introductions of game generated by the TFCA initiative and a healthy donation from the Department of Environmental Affairs to the Royal Jozini game reserve. However, in their capacity as the implementing agency for this donation, Ezemvelo KZN Wildlife disappointed all and reneged on their 2010 commitments at the last hour citing financial problems. The 2010 donation which was in excess of R1,250,000.00 is comprised as follows:

50 Zebra
244 Impala
50 Warthog
125 Blue Wildebeest
50 Kudu
20 Waterbuck
95 Nyala



All of this game was destined to be introduced into the Nature reserve generating the necessary game sightings for you all. Whilst 2010 is almost at an end, the good news is that this donation has been resurrected and we plan to introduce the same numbers during the course of 2011 starting in the beginning of the capture season – April. We hope that by next year's rainy season, this issue will be a thing of the past.
